- 3. Height Pump must be rated at 70 decibels or lower
- 4. East side of garage, proposed fill for sidewalk will need to be retained along property line with native basalt retaining walls
- 5. Proposed fill in front and sides of house will not be approved. If fill is needed for front steps and sidewalk, the fill will need to be retained with native basalt retaining walls. Natural grade should be retained unless you have a specific need, if so, you need to show a proposed plan/design.

Suggestions from the ARC

- 1. If you want to maximize solar panel space for the future, consider
 - Satellite dish under deck rather on the roof
 - Consolidate plumbing vents in attic so just one vents come thru roof
 - Fireplace vent in south wall rather than roof
- 2. Install propane on the deck where you want your grille, no more propane containers
- 3. Wire or conduit from electric box to attic for future solar panels
- 4. Remove front door closet, make pantry larger, then install washer and dryer, consider stacked units
- 5. Use obscure glass in bathroom windows
- 6. Closet door by front door, consider bifold door
- 7. Sound wall between guest bedroom and living room
- 8. Consider pocket doors for: Master Bath, Master Closet, Pantry
- 9. Consider out swing doors for: Front Door, Kitchen to Garage, Garage to outside.
